“Empadronamiento e Arraigo in Spagna: il contributo del Servicio de Atención al Inmigrante (SAI) del Comune di Granada”

The presentation addresses the procedures of *Empadronamiento* and *Arraigo* in Spain, as well as the role played by the *Servicio de Atención al Inmigrante (SAI)* of the Municipality of Granada in these procedures. In particular, regarding *Empadronamiento*, the focus will be on the registration of irregular migrants in the municipal registry. Concerning *Arraigo*, attention will be directed towards the ordinary regularization procedure aimed at the migrant's integration, which is established through family, social or economic ties. The paper thus aims to share knowledge about procedures and expertise developed in institutional contexts across other European countries in the fields of social protection and human mobility. It is part of the project “*Global social work and human mobility: comparative studies on local government and good social work practices in the Euro-Mediterranean region*” (Global-ANSWER-H2020-MSCA-RISE-GA-872209), which seeks to foster international and interdisciplinary cooperation by promoting the exchange of good practices through its network of scholars and professionals.
