**“Approches internationales des recherches universitaires sur le travail social. La place spécifique des enseignants-chercheurs comme médiateur du décroisement des savoirs” as part of the “Table ronde: animée par Gisèle Dambuyant”**

What role do Italian enseignants-chercheurs (teacher-researchers) play in the field of social intervention? What is their stance toward the beneficiaries of the social inclusion projects in which they are involved? Do they speak about them, speak on their behalf, or do they help amplify their voices? Are these issues discussed among academic and non-academic actors working within Italy's migrant reception system? This roundtable intervention will begin with these questions, seeking to explore possible answers through a reflection on the research and mobility experiences developed within the project “Global Social Work and Human Mobility: Comparative Studies on Local Government and Good Social Work Practices in the Euro-Mediterranean Region” (Global-ANSWER – H2020-MSCA-RISE-GA-872209), which provided the opportunity to explore and compare migrant reception models in Tuscany and Andalusia.
